

PATA Minutes 4/6/17

Quorum was not met; the meeting was changed to a working group

-There was an update on the NOFA timeline, HUD signaled that the NOFA will be dropped in May regardless of congressional action. This could mean the NOFA is released without tiers or other funding information, which would be corrected later.

-HUD is calling for people to look at the interim rules and submit comments to HUD on their website. They cannot change make a change without a comment.

-There will be more focus on system performance measures in the NOFA this year

-New project review committee is going to meet on May 8; we need 5-9 non-conflicted members. Interested individuals should contact Kirk.

-The appeals committee needs formed with 5-9 members. Interested non-conflicted individuals should contact Kirk or Gabie.

-Initial rankings are out. There may still be some errors in scores, especially in drawdown. We will update these and allow projects to make changes. Damien Center and Englewood's grant years haven't closed, so their drawdown may go up.

- We need to examine the HMIS data for Boner Special Needs/Scattered Site because they scored full points on housing stability, which seems unlikely

- We will send out the rankings by the end of the day Friday, ask for corrections within three weeks. They will have until April 28.

- Partners in Housing has consolidated all of their grants. This will make it very difficult to rank them because their grant amount is larger than all of tier 2. Adult and Child and Midtown both consolidated two projects. We need to more closely examine consolidations in the future.

- Letter of intent forms will be sent out and due back by May 3 at noon. We need to add FMR on the second page, and add threshold requirements to the first page.

-Request for Proposals, the advertising for new projects needs to take place; we need an information session that is optional for all new applicants. The RFP will be due on May 12, the information sessions will be held the week of April 24. There will also be a new projects meeting on May 15.
