TA Update – Committee extremely disappointed in the TA provided. Alicia will communicate with the City to ensure feedback is provided to HUD.

Focus on HUD CoC NOFA:

- Send out NOFA to whole CoC and encourage everyone to read it
- Main focus is on Systemic Response to Homelessness
- We need to have a Reallocation Policy in place – BOC has one we can look at theirs to jump start our policy
- Leverage is not showing up on NOFA at all so suggest remove from ranking project. Committee will reconfigure #'s to total 100 without leverage balance included.
- TAC is assisting with policy about how our programs operate in systemic fashion
- We need to develop common standards so we are pointing towards Coordinated Entry
- System Policies – short term get best of what we have for this year's NOFA and long term plan for next year to ensure all of this feeds into CE going forward with broader common perspective
- HUD is moving from planning to outcomes and results – so we have to move forward to show improvement over system measures
- Main Function for checking numbers is the PIT Count
- For system response we need to look at GPD beds and strategies to reduce #'s
- ESG funds are currently going to shelters and should go to RRH so we are showing an increase in RRH
- Need to ensure ongoing support for shelters as they are essential role
- Focus on getting monitoring done 2 x's for group with future plan on getting more in-depth for individual programs
- Grave concern for system issue is not being able to access Wheeler numbers as part of HMIS – Wheeler getting new data system and hopeful it will talk to HMIS
