

**COMMUNITY EDUCATION AND POLICY COMMITTEE
MEETING MINUTES
10-28-14**

- Installation of “kids” signs at Roberts Park
 - Would like to install Friday, November 14
 - Need 5-6 volunteers to install
 - Will send out “sign up genius” email link to recruit installation volunteers
 - Transport via HIP van or IMPD van
 - Awaiting word from RP about conflict with other event signage and exact timeline & placement of installation
 - **Roberts Park update via emails October 29** - we cannot get final confirmation from RP until November 10 due to pastor being out of town 1st week of November and possibility of conflict with other event banner. In the meantime Paul Harris is contacting Christ Church Cathedral about installing 11/14 for NHHA Week. Joan advises installing at both RP and CCC if we get green light from RP on 11/10. If RP wants us to wait until 11/24 Joan does not feel we can do two installations on two different dates. Shelley suggested if RP does not give green light on 11/10 then we install at RP November 24 for two weeks (week of Thanksgiving and first week in December) **How do committee members feel about all of this?**

- My Own 4 Walls film & panel discussion – 11/18/14
 - Panel will meet at the Central Library on November 4 to prepare for event
 - Signage up at the library this week, event posted on library, CHIP, and Continuum websites. Library will begin to share on social media November 1
 - Will need two volunteers for event to help collect questions on index cards from audience members
 - 4 tables and 8 chairs will be placed outside Clowes Auditorium for service providers and CHIP
 - Christy prepared some questions to be delivered to panel for inclusion in discussion; Joan is working on a hand-out

- Volunteers needed to assemble winter contingency kits at Horizon House on November 8 and November 28 at 8:00 am. Interested volunteers should contact Dawn Adams from Food4Souls, dawnadamsx2@gmail.com Rebecca Seifert may need a few volunteers for Shelter Health Fair in early December – she will contact Joan when she is sure of number needed.

- Paul Harris asked about doing a display at the library on youth, especially LGBT youth, experiencing homelessness; some discussion about clarity of messaging so suggestion was made to spotlight different sub-groups in different months in 2015. Note: book cart displays are easier and quicker to do and have more flexibility
- KNOW OUTLETS will have a display case promoting the campaign on the 3rd floor of Central Library in November and December – public/press campaign launch is November 7 at 10:30 on Georgia Street downtown

- City-County Council Rules and Public Policy Committee – November 11, Room 260, City-County Building – Leroy Robinson to introduce Homeless Bill of Rights
