

Indianapolis Continuum of Care Governance Charter Revisions October 3, 2016

- I.B.** Changed all references of “Blueprint 2.0” to “the Blueprint Plan”

Added that the support entity is also responsible for “Ensuring Blueprint Council members receive all necessary information regarding changes on the local, state, and federal level that may influence or impact the Continuum of Care.”

- II.A.** Added under Continuum of Care Written Standards responsibilities “Ensure written standards are followed through regular monitoring”

- II.B.** Voting rights have been further defined. Active participation is defined as having attended one meeting in the 12 months prior to the voting window

A process for soliciting new members and a diversity statement were added

- III.A.** **Blueprint council seats added:**

Elected Seats:

One Business representative (effective January 2018)

One Funder (effective January 2018)

One Affordable Housing developer (effective January 2018)

One Faith Based Liaison

One direct homeless service provider seat was changed so that it must be non-conflicted

Appointed seats:

IHA

Public Safety/Law Enforcement Official

Blueprint Council seats eliminated:

Elected Seats:

2 Members at Large

Appointed Seats:

CoC Program Grantee

- III.B.** The Blueprint council will review the election process every 5 years to ensure that it remains consistent with Continuum objectives and responsibilities

Added a Second Vice Chair position to serve as a parliamentarian

Officers serve One year terms instead of Two year terms

Creates responsibilities for the executive committee
