We have new projects approved in the application that we are hoping will receive funding: Rapid Rehousing for Youth (Adult & Child) and an expansion for existing Rapid Rehousing at Coburn and HIP. These are great opportunities for those families and youth we serve in shelter.

-John Boner's "Our Town" youth permanent supportive housing project will no longer be open once this round of funding begins, probably mid-2018.
