- I. Welcome & Introductions (2 mins) Nancy Lobdell & Bryan Dysert
- II. Coordinated Entry & Veterans (5 mins) Rachael Sample
 - a. Finishing policies and procedures, July 1 is the launch date. By June CHIP plans to start training orgs on how to use the VI-SPDAT. GPD not part of the launch, PSH and Rapid Rehousing are part of the launch. After these two groups, CE will focus on Veterans and GPD. Focused now on building out HMIS. ROI process is going to change
- III. Review of the Action Plan
 - a. Landlord Event - (5 mins) Lillian Herbers-Kelly
 - Event is tomorrow, will discuss the standard of care
 - Food provided by the Mayor's office
 - Helpers need to arrive at 8:00 am
 - 20 people are registered
 - b. Master List/ Case Conferencing (30 mins) Ken, Katie and Lauren
 - One option is to create a generic "services only" enrollment – HVAF has a program like this.
 - The Coordinated Entry enrollment could be the HMIS entry point. Once someone is permanently housed, they could be marked as inactive.
 - Everyone that is currently on the list is going to have to be enrolled in the Coordinated Entry enrollment.
 - Ken suggested making the Master List part of the CE pilot.
 - One of the issues with the list is that we are not capturing Veteran not enrolled in services
 - Ken is going to pull a list of everyone who has said that they are a veteran and then the Task Force must determine a process to verify Veteran status
 - Rachael is going to ask Dan to pull the list of anyone that has self identified as a Veteran
 - Master List process will remain the same for now
 - UWCI should set up a follow up meeting with CHIP and Ken to discuss the Master List and CE further
- IV. Combined SSVF Brochure (10 mins) Nancy & Bryan
 - a. The brochure is for VA staff – clinics and discharge planners
 - b. Include: agencies that provide SSVF services, contact number, blurb about the agency, blurb about SSVF
 - c. Agencies can send their blurbs to Rachael and she is willing to work on the combined brochure
