Leon – Faith Based Coordination Project, Leon Longard

Open Table is a faith based cooperative type project, lines up with missional community, looking at creating a group of 6 people from a church and essentially have a small group to support 1 individual, may work with SAMSA grants

Started having 1/month meetings with Melissa at HH, looking at how FBOG can look like PBSO (ethics/confidentiality), make sure our leadership knows that we can't share publicly, put together a MOU and how we accomplish similar goals together

Rachael Sample – looking at blueprint 3.0 reorganizing and retooling groups to do other work, work group grid put together by feedback from faith based group, faith based mtgs use to consist of broad range of outreaches so we decided to focus on housing/supportive piece, camp outreach; quarterly mtgs can invite back the broad range of outreaches and coordinated entry (is it valuable? – yes, to make connections for further purposes to help those we serve) 45 minutes speaker, 20 minutes questions; talk about housing and what is available, June 29th, September 28th, November or January: attendee asked about having a handout put together of all organizations and what they do; Leon suggested an LGBT community speaker be invited; look at grid and see if anything needs to be addressed and make sure to communicate that with Rachael

Updates on Continuum: currently launching plan for 3.0, steering committee mix of key players of certain fields of population; will have 10 info sessions with groups amongst community to help prepare plan; anticipating largest pot of money to serve homeless individuals, can submit apps now for housing types; Wheeler Mission will begin sharing data with CHIP to enter into HMIS and started talks with other groups (HMIS/Medicaid), Corrections...one reason using to locate those individuals we can't find; Natl Alliance to end homelessness www.naeh.org; PIT count increase 10% homelessness 2% decrease in unsheltered homelessness
